PURPOSE: To Establish Requirements For Posting Information Under U. S. Department Of Labor Regulations,

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and U.S. Department of Environmental Quality.

GENERAL: The following information should be posted on bulletin boards on all Federal Aid projects for prime

contractors and subcontractors.

1. Posters:

PR-1022 (Title 18),

FHWA 1495 (Title 23-Section 113),

EEO Poster, and

Job Safety & Health Protection

- 2. Wage rates as published by the Department of Labor.
- 3. Company EEO policy statement.
- 4. A letter stating the names of the EEO Officer, DBE Liaison Officer, and Safety Officer for the company.
- 5. A letter to the County Engineer designating a responsible person and an alternate along with their telephone numbers to implement the traffic control plan.
- 6. Corps of Engineers Permit Form No. 4336.
- 7. 404 Permit (When required).
- 8. Storm Water Permit (When required).
- 9. Telephone numbers of physicians, hospitals, and/or ambulances.

<u>SUBCONTRACTORS</u>: For subcontractors, with contracts in excess of \$10,000.00, it will be permissible for the prime and subcontractor to utilize the same bulletin board if all required information is displayed.
