SUBJECT: PAINTED TRAFFIC MARKINGS

Section S-619, Painted Traffic Markings of the 1989 Edition of the Mississippi Standard Specifications for State Aid Road & Bridge Construction is hereby amended as follows:

After the last (second) paragraph of Subsection S-619.02--Materials as amended by Special Provision 901-S-619-1 add the following:

Temporary raised pavement markers shall meet the requirements of this section and Section S-720 as amended by Special Provision 901-S-720-2.

901-S-619.09--Temporary Traffic Striping: After the last (third) paragraph of Subsection S-619.09 on page 6-65, add the following:

901-S-619.09.1--Temporary Raised Pavement Markers:

When noted on the plans temporary raised pavement markers shall be installed as per manufacturers recommendation or as directed by the Engineer. The temporary raised markers shall be flexible reflective tabs placed at forty (40) feet intervals on the centerline of the roadway. The markers shall be installed in a manner that reflective faces of the marker are perpendicular to a line parallel to roadway centerline.

If in the opinion of the Engineer, the temporary raised markers require removing after permanent striping has been accomplished, they shall be removed in such a manner that the pavement surface will not be unnecessarily damaged.

901-S-619.11-Basis of Payment:

After the (third) paragraph of Subsection S-619.11 on page 6-66, add the following:

When temporary raised markers are shown on the plans there shall be no separate pay item for this portion of work. The contractor shall include the material and labor for installation of these markers in the Maintenance of Traffic Pay Item No. 901-S-618.
